

ADDENDUM 4

1. Schedule 1 requires three contracts performed in Texas within the past three years. Where a vendor has not previously contracted in Texas, may comparable government aerial imagery contracts performed in other states be substituted?

They may be submitted with the proposal and will be considered in light of the scheduled requirements and the submissions of other proposals.

2. The Statement of Work scope references aerial oblique and orthophoto imagery, but detailed specifications are provided only for orthophotography. Please confirm whether oblique imagery is a required base deliverable, and if so, the required GSD, look angles, overlap, and delivery format.

Obliques are a required deliverable. The only requirements at this time are the ones listed in the proposal. The proposals will be compared based on the specifications of obliques provided by the vendor in comparison with other proposals.

3. Does the District require minimum forward overlap (endlap) and side overlap (sidelap) percentages for the orthophotography acquisition? If no minimums are specified, please confirm that vendor-proposed overlap sufficient to achieve the required accuracy standard and the building-lean minimization objective is acceptable.

The only accuracy standards are those listed in the RFP. Vendors providing such specifications will be compared with the other proposals.

4. The contract term mentioned in the Proposal Form Sec.2 is twelve (12) months, would the District consider a longer term contract? If so, how many years?

The RFP / contract is for 12 months but may be renewed for 2 additional years (3 total).
